Introduction

The Social Welfare Organization of Ampara district (SWOAD), has been established on 01.08.1995 by Mr. S. Senthurajah and functioning with his guidance. It is an organization founded with the aim of fulfilling the needs of vulnerable community targeted in Ampara district and with mechanism to provide better services and equal opportunities for them.

This organization focusing in coastal area of Ampara district, carries out activities incorporating Tamil, Muslim Communities in 54 villages situated within the administrative limits of Divisonal Secretariats namely Pothuvil, Thirukkovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Sammanthurai, Navithanveli and Uhana for the last one decade.

With the head office located at Akkaraipattu, this organization maintains 07 offices at Divisional level and 54 branch offices at village level in 7 Divisional Secretariat Divisions for carrying out its activities.



5. Vocational Training Infrastructure:

Under this Work Plan, Vocational Training Structure has been constructed on par with NVQ quality in Thirukkovil and Kalmunai DS divisions and vocational trainings on Carpentry, and Electrician are conducted. 8. Water and Sanitation:

• Construction of Latrine :

This Action Plan has been implemented with financial support of Christian Aid. Families affected by tsunami in Kalmunai and Karaitivu villages were target group and this action plan implemented. Under this action Plan, families who have no toilet facilities have been identified and action is taken to construct 168 toilets for the needy. Also awareness seminars on health was conducted for the beneficiaries by the Public Health Officer

• Construction of Common Drinking water Wells :

This Action Plan has been implemented with financial support of Christian Aid. Families affected by war and tsunami in Navithanveli, Kalmunai ,Karaitivu and Sammanthurai villages were target group and this action plan implemented to construct 50 Public Wells. This project was undertaken in locations where people suffer due to problem of Drinking water . It is notable that a user group including the beneficiaries, has been formed to maintain the wells in proper manner.

9. Awareness Seminars.

Several Awareness Seminars are conducted in 60 villages of Tamil, Sinhala and Muyslim communities within the administrative limits of Pothuvil, Thirukkovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Sammanthurai, Navithanveli and Uhana. The awareness seminars cover issues such as Children Maintenance, Protection of environment, Health, Nutrition, DRR, HIV/AIDS, Addicted to liquor, Early marriage, Child right, Gender equality, Peace & harmoney as well as the methodologies for them to have access to assistance from Government Departments easily and handle problems of common interest. People have been strengthened through these seminars to a great extent, Organizations Christian Aid, Diakonia helped to provide financial assistance to implement this project activities.

10. Capacity and Skill development of CBO Leaders and Staff:

In order to improve the capacity of Staff, working at village, Divisional and District levels, several trainings have been provided for staff with financial support of Diakonia and Dan Church Aid and their capacities improved. The issues such as Community structure, micro credit management, Goat breeding, Business Management, market Gardening management, Financial management, Proposal Writing, Gender, DRR, HIV/AIDS, Leadership, Project management, Report Writing etc covered in his training program







11. Education

• A/L Classes Conducted:

With the aim of promoting educational level among students of remote villages such as Pothuvil and Navithanveli free classes have been conducted for AL students. The subjects covered were Political Science, Tamil, Hindu culture Logic and Hinduism by efficient teachers. Also, additional revisions classes conducted. There were 175 students both male female attended to these classes. It is notable that 26 students have been qualified for admission to University. The organization DIAKONIA provided financial assistance for this program.

• O/L Classes Conducted:

With the aim of promoting educational level among students of remote villages such as Pothuvil and Navithanveli free classes have been conducted for OL students. The subjects covered were Mathematics, Science and English by efficient teachers. Also, additional revisions classes conducted. There were 53 students both male female attended to these classes. The organizations DIAKONIA and Dan Church Aid provided financial assistance for this program.

• Conducted Scholarship Classes:

With the aim of promoting educational level at Scholarship Examination among students of remote villages such as Thirukkovil and Navithanveli free classes have been conducted for students who sit for the scholarship examination. The subjects covered were Science, Tamil, and English by efficient teachers. Also, additional revisions classes conducted. There were 180 students both male female attended to these classes. It is notable that one student of Navithanveli passed the scholarship examination for the first time and 5 students of Thirukkovil area were successful at the examination. The organization Dan church Aid provided financial assistance for this program.







12. Environment Development:

It has been observed that the surrounding and environment have been polluted and affected as a result of tsunami and war situation in the coastal area and most of trees were devastated. And that these areas appear barren and dried. Taking into consideration of this condition, with the financial support of Dan Church Aid, plants of useful trees were distributed for people in these areas, planted in the compound of their houses and maintained by them.
