

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01. Introduction: - In 1990 and afterwards due to the war, violence and racial conflict, the people were physically and morally affected and were without sleep or tired and backward. The need to raise the standard of living and prosper in their lives in a better life for all is the main reason of the inception of the Organization

Mr.Shanmugam Senthurajah was consious to start an NGO in the Ampara district to serve the war & violence affected people. He invited the important people in the different Divisional Secretariat Division in the Ampara District for a discussion meeting. In accordance with the discussion, Social Welfare Organization Ampara District (SWOAD) is formed on the 1st of August 1995

This Organization focusing on the Tamil, Muslim and Sinhalease people of 18 villages in the Pottuvil, Thirukovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Navithanveli and Samanthurai DS Division which is in the Coastal Belt of Ampara District and formed women member groups and with the women leadership and functioned. Initially to these groups saving habit is introduced and used the savings as revolving loan. During this period Netherland Embassy came forward to assist us with finance. Using this fund as a capital, we have given this fund as loan to the affected women headed families to start an income generating trade.

Also training was given to the staffs who are working in these villages and these staff through the training they obtained imparted the knowledge to the vulnerable group of people to involve in savings, provided assistance to develop the economy and the guidance and led them to the welfare of the community

During these period of service, Diakonia, OXFAM, Helvetas, Save the children Norway, UNICEF, World Food Program, WUSC etc came forward to assist us. Through these assistance, we could be able to conduct Vocational Training, Children Development Program, Awareness Workshops, Water & Sanitation, Housing, Human Rights programs, Education, Preschools, Libraries, Nutrition programs

When the Donors seen the extension and rapid growth of the Organization, they praised our Organization and also a few more International Organization came forward to provide financial support. Through this assistance we could be able to fulfill the basic needs of the vulnerable people of the District. In 2000, we have decentralized and formed SWOAD Offices in Pottuvil, Thirukovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Navithanveli and Samanthurai Division. And the responsibilities to run the division independently and make decision of their own are given to the Divisional administrative staffs. To do so we have given the needed trainings to the staffs. Now they are able to run the division smoothly without any hindrance or problems.

Now we have 7742 members in 58 villages with 187 staffs. Our services are smoothly proceeding with the guidance of Mr.S.Senthurajah. You could see what we have achieved and what are we going to achieved in the future in the inner pages.

2.1.4 Providing Vocational Training

The vulnerable youth who could not be able to continue their higher studies were provided with a Vocational Training so that they could be able to earn a living for the family. With the 5 Million rupees financial assistance of WUSC, constructed a building for Carpentry Training at Pottuvil and a building for Tractor Mechanism Training at Navithanveli. The following training courses were conducted for 174 Youths of both sexes with the financial assistance of 4,722,100.00 provided by ODW Organization

2.2 Social Development Project

2.2.1 Educational Development Activities

Our Organization has conducted the following activities for the betterment of the poor vulnerable children who has the desire to continue their studies with the financial support of DCA & DIAKONIA

- Conducting rapid revision classes for the GCE(A/L) students The rapid revision classes for the GCE(A/L) students of Thirukovil and Navithanveli Division on Hindu Culture, Hinduism, Politics, Tamil, Drama and logic for 528 students with the cost of 280,000/=
- Conducting rapid revision classes for the GCE(O/L) students The rapid revision classes for the GCE(O/L) students of Pottuvil and Samanthurai Division on Mathermatics, Science and English for 83 students with the cost of 213,000/=

2.2.2 Providing financial assistance for Education. Provided 75,000/= per months for 12 Months totaling 900,000/= Financial assistance for Education in the Pottuvil, Thirukovil, Karaitivu, Samanthurai, Kalmunai, Navithanveli and Alayadivembu for 150 GCE(A/L) students

- **2.2.3 Children Development Activities:-** To grow the model talented future community, the following children development activities are conducted children welfare, self desire, Rights
- Errecting a Preschool: A preschool worth of 5,000,000/= is constructed at the selected village of Valathapitti in the Samanthurai DS Division with the Financial support of Basket Fund Project. 42 children are studing in the school
- Conducting Preschool Under children development project 15 Preschools are conducted with the support of DCA & DIAKONIA and 13 Schools are conducted with the support of SWOAD Organization in the SWOAD operational area of Pottuvil, Thirukovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Samanthurai and Navithanveli DS Divisions. 480 male and 529 female students are studying and 52 teachers are working in these schools

- **Providing Nutritious food** 1,000,000/= worth of Nutritious food is supplied to500 malnurished children of the 15 selected preschools in the Organizational working areas of Pottuvil, Thirukovil, Karaitivu, Kalmunai, Navithanveli and Samanthurai DS Divisions, with the support of DCA and Diakonia





- Erecting a Children Park A children Park is erected at Sinnapanankadu village in the Alayadivembu DS Division which costed 1,960,000/=. This financial assistance was provided by the NECCDEP. 175 children are using this park daily
 - **2.2.4 Women Development:** Increase the self income of the women in the society, through providing equal status to women without any sexual discrimination, create women leadership and awareness and make them to take decision by themselves. To do so the following activities were implemented in the Organization (Oxfam, Diakonia, CA, NCA)
- Increase the income by encouraging them to involve in saving habits
- Providing self employment loan under Livelihood activities
- Providing job opportunities through Vocational Training and advises
- Implement development activities through the Groups
- Conducted capacity building training workshops on Gender equity, Leadership, Family understanding, economical development,
- Create Leadership
- Provide training on capacity building of women
- Reduce the violence against women
- Encourage the women to involve in Non traditional trade







- **2.2.5 Infrastructure Development :-** SWOAD is Implementing the following activities to make the community selfsufficient in their living by developing the Livelihood to fulfill the basic needs of the poor vulnerable community
 - Housing: Under intergrated Social Rehabilitation Development program, 20 permanent houses have been constructed at Samanthurai and 19 houses at Navithanveli DS divisions for 19,600,000/= with the assistance of CA
 - Renovation of 85 houses have been constructed at Navithanveli for the selected 85 beneficiaries with the Financial assistance of DCA/FCA for 25,625,000/=





■ Water & Health:- Under intergrated Social Rehabilitation Development program, 20 latrines and 20 individual wells were constructed at Navithanveli DS Division for 2,840,000/= with assistance of DCA/FCA and with the assistance of NECCDEP 4 common wells were constructed at Sinnapanagadu, Thampaddai, Thambiluvil and Vinyagapuram for 1,703,000/= and a Latrine with fencing at Sangamangramam for 573,500/=





■ Erecting Rain water harvesting tank, Erected 2 Rain water harvesting tank at Pottuvil, Thirukovil 3 tanks, Navithanveli 3 tanks, Valarthapity village in the Samanthurai Division one and Thuraivanthiyamedu in the Kalmunai Division one totaling 10 tanks with the assistance of CA for 530,000/=





- **Multipurpose Building :-** Under Superstructure project 3 Multipurpose Building were constructed at Vinayagapuram, Sinnapanangadu and Thamapaddai for 6,186,000/= with the assistance of NECCDEP
- **Fishermen Rest Room** 2 Fishermen Rest room were constructed at Thamapaddai and Thambiluvil for 2,222,000/= with the assistance of NECCDEP
- **Road Renovation** Under Superstructure project 3 Roads were renovated at Thampaddai 1 & 2 and Sinnapanangadu for 4,009,500/= with the assistance of NECCDEP
- **2.2.6 Awareness Activities:-** Under intergrated Social Rehabilitation Development program, conducted 143 awareness workshops on the following topics for 5335 beneficiaries in the 6 working DS divisions
 - _ TOT training on Health and Nutrition
 - _ Training on Women's Right, Gender equality, and Leadeship
 - _ Training on Health & Nutrition for village people
 - _ The importance of child education

Under CA – DRR Program, Nature Farming, Climate change, DRR, Water Management, Increase the Marketing facilities etc. 49 training programs were conducted. 2234 beneficiaries participated in this training.







2.3 Health development Program:- Under intergrated Social Rehabilitation Development program, Medical assistance worth 600,000/= of medicine were provided for 1200 members in Samanthurai, Navithanveli and Kalmunai divisions







2.7 Environmental Development Project

■ **Nature Farming:-** Under intergrated Social Rehabilitation Development program, 10 Nature Farming training workshops were conducted for 310 Farmers with the cost of 39,000/=., to establish Model farms 25,000/= each was provided for 5 farmers. To do nature home gardening, 5.000/= each was provided to 20 Nature farmers.







Under CA- DRR Projects, in 10 villages conducted training on nature home gardening for 300 village people with the cost of 39,000/=, 5000/= worth of seeds were issued for 10 farmer families. Also for 50 families, 5,000/= each was issued to do home gardening

2.8 Community Intergrated development project supported by Oxfam .

Three farmers groups were strengthen in Pattuvil and Thirukovil divisions. Total 34 groups are formed and 862 farmers join in the group.

All the groups were given capacity building training. They are also given technical training on good farming practices. The farmer representatives were taken to see model farms.

Organic farming practices were introduced to the farmers group. Experts from India trained our farmers in Organic cultivation.

All the farmers in three villages from two divisions come together and formed a farmer's organization call Sustainable Agriculture Resource Centre-SARC. This centre is providing many services to the farmers. They are providing tractor, Harvester, Soparayers on a rental bsis to the famers with fewer charges.

A Seed processing centre and a paddy store is constructed to support the farmers to get a good variety of seed paddy.

The SARC is linked with government authorities and services providers to mange it effectively by the farmers group. The formed 34 groups were given training on different thems to mage the groups effectively. Income genetration activities were initated by all the group members and support by this project.

The 34 groups were given revolving fund to revolve it among it's members for Income generation activities.

■ Providing Anaki fire stove Selected 10 villages Selected 10 families in 10 selected villages villages in the 6 working division for providing training on to make Anaki Stove which costed 23,000/= and selected 2 women from the trained 10 families and provided 187,500/= to makr 750 Anaki Stove. These 750 stoves were issued to 750 families in the Kalmunai, Karaitivu, Samanthurai, Navithanveli Thirukovil and Pottuvil Divisions. Also printed 2000 posters on usage of Anaki stove which costed 50,000/= and distributed to 10 villages at 200 posters for each village.







■ Planting Fruit trees :- 10 villages selected in the 6 working division. In each village 100 families were selected to distribute fruit plants and issued 3000 seedlings of Guova, Jak and Mango
